The Great Famine-Genocide In Ukraine

In 1932-1933, the Soviet Communist Party under Joseph Stalin's leadership imposed an artificial famine, Holodomor, in Ukraine. By the end of 1933, 10 million innocent victims, including 3 million children, had perished from starvation through a deliberate Soviet policy to crush the Ukrainian peasantry and industrialize the USSR.
